We land in the midst of an argument between Ferrando and Guglielmo on one side and their older, more experienced friend Don Alfonso on the other. Ferrando and Guglielmo believe that their girlfriends will be true to them no matter what. They bet money that Don Alfonso cannot prove them wrong, and agree to do whatever Don Alfonso requires of them in his scheme to disprove their beliefs.

DUET Ah guarda sorella

RECIT Mi par che stammatina

We meet the girlfriends in question, sisters Fiordiligi and Dorabella, who sing of their admiration for their boyfriends and of their devotion.

ACT I, scene iii

Don Alfonso, Fiordiligi, Dorabella

ARIETTA Vorrei dir Don Alfonso

RECIT Stelle, per carita

Don Alfonso enters and, in rather dramatic fashion, informs the women that their boyfriends have been called to military service. The hoax begins!

Guglielmo, Ferrando, Don Alfonso, Fiordiligi, Dorabella

QUINTET Sento, o Dio
RECIT Non piangere

DUETTINO Al fato dan legge Ferrando, Guglielmo

RECIT La commedia e graziosa

The four lovers embark upon a prolonged farewell.

ACT I, scene v

Chorus, Don Alfonso, Fiordiligi, Dorabella, Ferrando, Guglielmo

CHORUS Bella vita militar
RECIT Non v'e più tempo

QUINTET Di scrivermi
CHORUS Bella vita militar

The farewell continues, with a military march from the chorus.

ACT I, scene vi

Dorabella, Don Alfonso, Fiordiligi

RECIT Dove son?

TRIO Soave sia il vento

Don Alfonso and the women call on the waves and winds to be gentle with the ship carrying the men to war.

ACT I, scene vii

Don Alfonso

RECIT Non son cattivo comico

Don Alfonso gives himself a preemptive pat on the back.

ACT I, scene viii

Despina

RECIT Che via maledetta

We meet Despina, who complains about having to be a ladies' maid.

ACT I, scene ix

Despina, Fiordiligi, Dorabella

RECIT Madame, ecco la vostra collazione
RECIT Ah scostati Dorabella
ARIA Smanie implacabili Dorabella

RECIT Signora Dorabella

ARIA In uomini, in soldati Despina

Fiordiligi and Dorabella pour out their hearts to Despina, who suggests to them that they should be less attached to their absent men and try to have some fun.

ACT I, scene x & xa

Don Alfonso

RECIT Che silenzio

Don Alfonso, Despina

RECIT Despinetta!

Don Alfonso enlists Despina's help. The reward for her cooperation will be financial.

ACT I, scene xi

Don Alfonso, Ferrando, Guglielmo, Despina, Fiordiligi, Dorabella

SEXTET Alla bella Despinetta

RECIT Che susurro, che strepito

RECIT *Temerari* Fiordiligi ARIA *Come scoglio* Fiordiligi

RECIT Ah non partite

ARIA Non siate ritrosi Guglielmo

Don Alfonso introduces Ferrando and Guglielmo, disguised, to Despina. Despina is to pave the way with the women. The women appear and rebuff the strangers roundly.

Don Alfonso, Ferrando, Guglielmo

TRIO E voi ridete?
RECIT Si puo sapere

ARIA Un'aura amorosa Ferrando

Ferrando and Guglielmo are ready to celebrate their triumph.

ACT I, scene xiii

Don Alfonso, Despina

RECIT La saria da ridere

Despina assures Don Alfonso that Fiordiligi and Dorabella will give in.

ACT I, scene xiv

Fiordiligi, Dorabella

DUET Ah, che tutta in un momento

Fiordiligi and Dorabella bemoan their fate.

ACT I, scene xv

Ferrando, Guglielmo, Don Alfonso, Fiordiligi, Dorabella, Despina

SEXTET Si mora si

The strangers claim to have poisoned themselves, inspiring pity in Fiordiligi and Dorabella, who call for a doctor.

ACT I, scene xvi

Don Alfonso, Ferrando, Guglielmo, Despina, Fiordiligi, Dorabella

SEXTET Eccovi il medico

Despina enters disguised as a doctor, and heals the strangers. The strangers get fresh with Fiordiligi and Dorabella, who rebuff them again.

ACT II, scene i

Despina, Fiordiligi, Dorabella

RECIT Andate la

ARIA Una donna Despina

Despina advises Fiordiligi and Dorabella to toy with the strangers, and shows them how to do so.

ACT II, scene ii

Fiordiligi, Dorabella

RECIT Sorella, cosa dici?

DUET Prendero quel bruttino

Fiordiligi and Dorabella confer and decide to give it a go. Dorabella will go for the brown haired one (Guglielmo, who is Fiordiligi's boyfriend in disguise). Fiordiligi will go for the blond one (Ferrando, who is Dorabella's boyfriend in disguise). Uh-oh.

ACT II, scene iii

Don Alfonso, Dorabella

RECIT Ah, correte al giardino

Don Alfonso summons the sisters to the garden.

ACT II, scene iv

Ferrando, Guglielmo, Chorus, Don Alfonso, Fiordiligi, Dorabella, Despina

DUET Secondate aurette amiche Ferrando, Guglielmo, Chorus

RECIT Il tutto deponete

QUARTET La mano a me date Don Alfonso, Ferrando, Guglielmo, Despina

The strangers, with the help of the chorus, serenade the sisters. Don Alfonso and Despina move them closer together.

ACT II, scene v

Fiordiligi, Ferrando, Dorabella, Guglielmo

RECIT Oh che bella giornata!

DUET Il core vi dono Guglielmo, Dorabella

After an incredibly awkward moment, Guglielmo and Dorabella, left alone, come to an understanding.

ACT II, scene vi

Ferrando, Fiordiligi

RECIT Barbara, perche fuggi?

ARIA Ah lo veggio Ferrando

Ferrando woos Fiordiligi.

ACT II, scene vii

Fiordiligi

RECIT Ei parte...senti...ah no

ARIA Per pieta, ben mio, perdona

Fiordiligi feels absolutely terrible about potentially betraying her boyfriend, and resolves not to do so.

ACT II, scene viii

Ferrando, Guglielmo

RECIT Amico, abbiamo vinto!

ARIA Donne mie Guglielmo

Guglielmo is appreciative of Ferrando's lack of progress with his own girlfriend Fiordiligi, but is not so sensitive to Ferrando's feelings when he shares his success with Ferrando's girlfriend Dorabella.

ACT II, scene ix

Ferrando, Don Alfonso, Guglielmo

RECIT In qual fiero contrasto Ferrando ARIA Tradito, schernito Ferrando

RECIT Bravo! questa e costanza

Don Alfonso joins Ferrando and Guglielmo. Ferrando is really upset.

ACT II, scene x

Despina, Dorabella, Fiordiligi

RECIT Ora vedo

ARIA E Amore un ladroncello Dorabella

Dorabella now firmly believes that one has to submit to the whims of Love.

ACT II, scene xi

Fiordiligi, Guglielmo, Despina, Don Alfonso

RECIT Come tutto congiuro

Fiordiligi resolves to dress as a soldier, along with Dorabella, and go to war with Ferrando and Guglielmo.

ACT II, scene xii

Fiordiligi, Ferrando

DUET Fra gli amplessi

When Ferrando (disguised) arrives, Fiordiligi loses her resolve.

ACT II, scene xiii

Guglielmo, Don Alfonso, Ferrando

RECIT Ah, poveretto me

ARIETTA Tutti accusan le donne Don Alfonso

Guglielmo has seen himself betrayed. Don Alfonso tells Ferrando and Guglielmo that no woman is perfect and that they might as well commit themselves, now that they know this. "Cosi fan tutte" - "All woman do this (behave this way)"

ACT II, scene xiv

Despina, Ferrando, Guglielmo, Don Alfonso

RECIT Vittoria, padroncini

The women have instructed Despina to call in a notary to marry them to the strangers.

ACT II, scene xv

Despina, Chorus, Don Alfonso

FINALE Fate presto

Wedding preparations are made.

ACT II, scene xvi

Chorus, Fiordiligi, Dorabella, Ferrando, Guglielmo

FINALE, continued Benedetti i doppi conjugi

E nel tuo, nel mio bicchiero

The chorus blesses the couples, the couples come together.

ACT II, scene xvii

Don Alfonso, Fiordiligi, Dorabella, Ferrando, Guglielmo, Despina, Chorus

FINALE, continued Miei Signori, tutto e fatto

Despina arrives, disguised as a notary, and performs the wedding ceremony. As the couples are signing, the military march is heard. As Fiordiligi and Dorabella panic, the strangers disappear.

ACT II, scene xviii

Ferrando, Guglielmo, Don Alfonso, Fiordiligi, Dorabella, Despina

FINALE, continued Sani e salvi agli amplessi amorosi

V'inganni, ma fu l'inganno

Fortunato l'uom che prende

Ferrando and Guglielmo return as themselves. The men reveal the full scope of the hoax, surprising even Despina, who was not aware that the strangers were Ferrando and Guglielmo in disguise. Accord is rather swiftly reached, and all sing a hymn to reason.
